3. The motion for attorney's fees is granted and the County of Loudoun shall reimburse the Defendant the sum of \$ 35,623.35 to cover the legal fees and other costs associated with the defense of this suit.

4. The proceedings of the Special Grand Jury shall remain under seal.

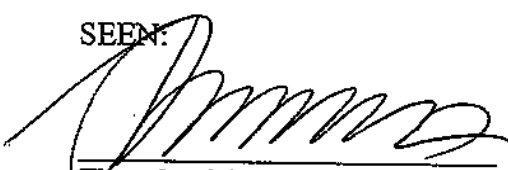
